

Corrigenda and addenda to Systematic notes on Asian birds 34-40 in Zoologische Verhandelingen Leiden 344

- p. 45 *Chloropsis cyanopogon septentrionalis*. We dated this 1918, which was taken from the signature details within this paper. However Deignan (1963) dated this Feb. 25, 1919 and was correct. David Wells has a copy in the original wrapper.
- p. 49 *Irena tweeddalii* is given as the original spelling. Sharpe intended to describe this in a paper which was delayed (Sharpe, 1877c) but there too Sharpe used *tweeddalii* as he did in *Cat. Birds Brit. Mus.*, which appeared first. Dickinson et al. (1991) inexplicably erred in citing the spelling from the latter source as *tweeddalei*. This emended spelling seems to date from Sharpe's Handlist in 1901 and to have been followed by Delacour & Mayr (1946), duPont (1971), Dickinson et al. (1991) and Kennedy et al. (2000). We considered it to be in prevailing usage, but this may be irrelevant.
