10. ON A COLLECTION OF THE MUSEUM OF BASLE, WITH DESCRIPTION OF A NEW SPECIES OF APOCRYPTODON

The following is a description of the new species.

Apocryptodon wirzi nov. spec.

D. 1 VI; D. 2 I. 27?; A. I. 27?; L.l. \pm 78; L.tr. 18; Predorsal scales \pm 32.

Body elongate, compressed; height 7 in length, $8\frac{1}{2}$ in total length. Head depressed, 4 in length, 5 in total length. Eyes about 7 in head; interorbital less than 1 eye-diameter. Snout about as long as eye, tip before inferior margin of eye. Jaws subequal, maxillary extends to $1\frac{1}{2}$ eye-diameter behind eye. Teeth in upper jaw in a row of about 14 teeth on each side, which are truncate to bilobate; before these 14 teeth on each side a curved canine. In lower jaw a row of about 20 teeth on each side, which are subhorizontal and bilobate; before these teeth on each side 1—2 curved canines. On each side of symphysis an erected canine. Tongue nearly totally adnate to the floor of the mouth. Head scaled above behind the eyes, on cheeks and opercles. Scales of body cycloid, a little deciduous, about as large as those on head. D. 1 lower than body, longer than high. D. 2 very close behind the end of the membrane of D. 1. P. about as long as postorbital part of head. V. idem. C. about as long as head.

Colour: grayish-brown, silvery below. Head with a dark blotch on each side on cheeks and opercles. Body with \pm 15 indistinct bent transverse stripes. D. 2 with a dark blotch at the tip of the last rays. P. with dark transverse band over base. A. and V. light.

Length: 88 mm.

Habitat: Turama riv. Western Division British New Guinea.

Type specimen: Nr. 4218 Mus. Basle, Turama riv. Western Division British New Guinea, Dr. Wirz.

This species is allied to *Parapryptes* and *Apocryptichthys* in the number of scales and rays of D. 2 and A., at the other hand the teeth are bilobate as in *Apocryptodon*, the species of this genus have, however, a lower number of scales and finrays.
