In my previous paper "Male genitalia of the species of *Depressaria* Haworth s.l. (Lepidoptera, Oecophoridae) occurring in the Netherlands" (1964, Zool. Meded., 39: 391-408) the species *Agonopterix scopariella* (Heinemann) has been omitted from the key to the species.

On p. 395, the relevant paragraph should read:



One species should be added to the Dutch list, viz. *Agonopterix applana* (Fabricius). In the present note a drawing of the male genitalia of this species is presented together with the following short description. Cuiller not reaching to the costa, top bending outwards, sharply pointed. Gnathos elongate-ovate. Aedeagus index = 1 : 7.

The relevant addition to the key to the species in my former paper (p. 395) is as follows:




Fig. 1. *Agonopterix applana* (Fabricius) (gen. no. 3314, Leiden Museum),
