


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## RANGE EXTENSION IN THE PERIOD 1968 - 1970 OF THE ALIEN AMPHIPOD, *GAMMARUS TIGRINUS SEXTON, 1939*, IN THE NETHERLANDS

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### ABSTRACT

*Gammarus tigrinus* was introduced in the Netherlands around 1964. Previous papers recorded the spreading of this amphipod in the successive years. In the period 1968 - 1970, it has invaded new regions in the provinces of Friesland, Groningen, Overijssel, Gelderland, Noord-Holland and Zuid-Holland, as well as in the Noordoostpolder and Oostelijk Flevoland. The maximum progress made since 1967 is about 36 kilometers. It is recorded for the first time south of the river Rhine.

In three previous papers (Nijssen & Stock, 1966; Pinkster & Stock, 1967; Dennert, Dennert & Stock, 1968) the spreading of the alien amphipod, *Gammarus tigrinus* Sexton, 1939, in the northern part of the Netherlands has been recorded. The progress of the species, explosive in 1965, slowed gradually down in 1966 and 1967, and a new survey of the range of the amphipod was not undertaken until late 1969 — early 1970.

While the main progress in 1967 was made in southwestern direction, practically no new territory was invaded in that direction in 1969, with one very remarkable exception: the Brielsche Meer, in which the species developed explosively. Since this lake attracts many yachtsmen, it is not unlikely that *G. tigrinus* was introduced artificially into the lake, which would explain its absence in the central part of Zuid-Holland. An important range extension was now realized in northeastern direction, thus in an area where almost no gain was made in 1967. In Overijssel, and in the Noordoostpolder, where *G. tigrinus* was still absent in 1967, the species appeared now for the first time.

The fact that the species showed up in the Brielsche Meer is of some importance, because no more physical barriers (such as the highly polluted lower ranges of the Rhine) seem to be present now preventing its further spread through the province of Zeeland, and into Belgium and northern France.




Fig. 1. Previous distribution, and new records, of *Gammarus tigrinus* in The Netherlands.

The 62 records of *G. tigrinus*, which constitute an extension of the previously known range, are recorded in table I and in fig. 1. In addition, just outside the area occupied by *G. tigrinus*, several checks have been made, yielding either one of the common local species (*G. pulex*, *G. duebeni*, or *G. zaddachi*), or no gammarids at all. Such checks were made in Friesland (45 samples), Groningen (1 sample), Overijssel (20 samples), IJsselmeerpolders (9 samples), Gel-

derland (29 samples), Utrecht (8 samples), Noord-Holland (43 samples), Zuid-Holland (62 samples), Noord-Brabant (1 sample), and Zeeland (10 samples). This rather dense sampling grid makes the range limits of *G. tigrinus*, as recorded in fig. 1, pretty reliable.
