15.I.1979 - 30.III.1979

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All localities in Viti Levu and Vanua Levu can be found on the 1:250.000 maps, which are published by the Directorate of Overseas Surveys and are sold by Edward Stanford Ltd., 12-14 Long Acre, London WC2E 9LP.

Maps 1:50.00 of the Fiji Islands, contoured, are also sold by Edward Stanford Ltd. (a number of sheets in Viti Levu and Vanua Levu are not available). Based on these maps the Land Resources Division published 1:50.000 forest maps of the forested areas of Viti Levu and Vanua Levu with the Land Resource Study entitled Fiji Forest Inventory by M.J. Berry and W.J. Howard.

STATION.

1. Viti Levu, Tholoisuva, 10 km N of Suva, 150 m, 18.I.1979, lowland rainforest and road side.
2. Viti Levu, Tholoisuva near Forestry Station, 10 km N of Suva, 100 m, 19.I.1979, lowland rainforest.
3. Viti Levu, 5 km SW of Rakiraki along the road from Rakiraki to Vatukathevatheva, 100 m, 21.I.1979, grassland.
4. Viti Levu, Nakauvandra Range, Vatukathevatheva, 10 km SW of Rakiraki, 400-500 m, 21.I.1979, low stocked forest, partly disturbed, and gardens adjacent to grassland along creek on precipitous slope.
5. Viti Levu, Nakauvandra Range, Rewasa, 5 km SE of Rakiraki, 300-400 m, 22.I.1979, low stocked forest, partly disturbed, and gardens along creek with adjacent grassland on precipitous slope.
6. Viti Levu, Nakauvandra Range, Rewasa, 5 km SE of Rakiraki, 300 m, 22.I.1979, fruit-trees.

7. Viti Levu, Navai, S of Nandarivatu, 800 m, 24.I.1979, open secondary scrub in logged forest and forest trail on clay-soil.
8. Viti Levu, 5 km S. of Navai, S of Nandarivatu, 800 m, 24.I.1979, montane rainforest on precipitous slope.
9. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, Forestry Resthouse, 800 m, 24.I.1979, montane rainforest, disturbed forest and Pinus plantations, at light.
10. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, trail to Nanggaranambululi, 2 km E of Nandarivatu, 1000-1100 m, 25.I.1979, montane rainforest partly disturbed and trail sides.
11. Viti Levu, Mau, 30 km W of Suva, 27.I.1979, fringe forest.
12. Viti Levu, Tholoisuva, 100 m, 28.I.1979, secondary forest in recreation area.
13. Vanua Levu, Valembasonga, 5 km E of Lambasa, 30.I.1979, dry pole forest along narrow creek.
14. Vanua Levu, Valembasonga, 5 km E of Lambasa, 30.I.1979, road side in cultivated land, mainly sugarcane.
15. Vanua Levu, 5 km SW of Lambasa near the airport, 31.I.1979, open dry casuarina forest with undergrowth.
16. Vanua Levu, Nasarava creek, 15 km SSW of Lambasa (the road to Nasavara creek runs parallel and 4 km east of the road from Lambasa to Ndelaikoro) 200 m, 31.I.1979, disturbed rainforest.
17. Vanua Levu, 10 km S of Nanduri, 1.II.1979, fringe forest.
18. Vanua Levu, 10 km S of Nanduri, 1.II.1979, garden.
19. Vanua Levu, 5 km SW of Lambasa near the airport, 1.II.1979, open dry forest.
20. Vanua Levu, Wailevu river, 20 km SW of Lambasa, along the road to Ndelaikoro, near a village, 2.II.1979, disturbed rainforest and gardens.
21. Vanua Levu, Saivou along the new road to Savusavu, 20 km S of Nanduri, 250 m, 3.II.1979, garden with adjacent rainforest.
22. Vanua Levu, along the road to Ndelaikoro, some km N of Ndelaikoro, 250-500 m, 4.II.1979, montane rainforest.
23. Vanua Levu, 5 km S of Ngelemunu along the road from Lambasa to the northeast of Vanua Levu through the valley of the Nayarambale river, 5.II.1979, open dry vegetation with some trees and scrubs in cultivated land.
24. abandoned.
25. Vanua Levu, Savusavu, Travelodge Hotel, 7.II.1979, gardens, at light

26. Vanua Levu, Savundrondro, 5 km NEE of Savusavu, 100 m, 8.II.1979, lowland rainforest.
27. Vanua Levu, 2 km NW of Mbangasau along the branch road from the Hibiscus highway to Ndrekeniwai, and about 15 km NW of Mbutha Bay, 50 m, 9-10.II.1979, very wet rainforest on precipitous slope.
28. Vanua Levu, 5 km W of Mbutha Bay, along a trail running in northern direction from the Hibiscus highway to a sawmill, at a distance of 3 km from the Hibiscus highway, 11.II.1979, logged rainforest, road sides and sides of a narrow creek.
29. Vanua Levu, 2 km NW of Mbangasau along the branch road from the Hibiscus highway to Ndrekeniwai, and about 15 km NW of Mbutha Bay, 50 m, 11.II.1979, very wet rainforest on precipitous slope.
30. Vanua Levu, Tambia, Natewa Bay, 10 km N of Korolevu, 50 m, 12.II.1979, different types of forest, gardens and open, partly cultivated, land with creeks.
31. Vanua Levu, Savusavu, Travelodge Hotel, 12.II.1979, gardens, at light
32. Vanua Levu, Savundrondro, near Savundrondro dam of the water reservoir, 5 km NEE of Savusavu, 100 m, 13.II.1979, disturbed rainforest and some secondary growth with adjacent cultivated land.
33. Vanua Levu, Savundrondro, 5 km NEE of Savusavu, 14.II.1979, rainforest.
34. Taveuni, 4 km NE of Somosomo, 300 m, 17.II.1979, logged rainforest and grassland with light scrub and narrow creek.
35. Taveuni, Nanduvu creek, 5 km S of airstrip Matei, 17.II.1979.
36. Taveuni, 4 km NE of Somosomo, 300 m, 18.II.1979, logged rainforest.
37. Taveuni, Songgulu, 10 km SW of Waiyevo, 18.II.1979, disturbed rainforest and adjacent coconut plantation.
38. Laucala Island, NE of Taveuni, 21.II.1979, mangroves, secondary growth and adjacent rainforest.
39. Nggamea Island, NE of Taveuni, 21.II.1979, mangroves and gardens.
40. Taveuni, Songgulu, 10 km SW of Waiyevo, 22.II.1979, disturbed rainforest.
41. Taveuni, 4 km NE of Somosomo, 300 m, 22.II.1979, logged rainforest.
42. Taveuni, Nanggarawalu, South Taveuni, 150 m, 24.II.1979, disturbed rainforest with adjacent vegetable gardens.
43. Taveuni, Nanggarawalu, South Taveuni, along the innermost road running from the western to the eastern side of the island, 150 m, 24.II.1979, gardens with some solitary trees and adjacent rainforest.

44. Taveuni, 8 km S of Waiyevo, 24.II.1979, plantation along the coast
45. Viti Levu, Tholoisuva, 10 km N of Suva, 150 m, 26-27.II.1979, rainforest mahogany plantation.
46. SE of Viti Levu, 10 km W of Naimasimasi, 20 km NNW of Nausori SE of the Tailevu (Mahogany) Forest Plantation, 28.II.1979, primary lowland rainforest.
47. Viti Levu, Wailevu, 25 km N of Vunindawa, side road of the King's Road, running from Wailevu to Soa, 2.III.1979, steep slope with secondary forest and gardens.
48. Viti Levu, Nakauvandra Range, Rewasa, 5 km SE of Rakiraki, 300-400 m, 3.III.1979, low stocked forest partly disturbed and gardens along creek with adjacent grassland on precipitous slope.
49. Viti Levu, Wailevu, 25 km N of Vunindawa, caves in the narrow valley along the side road of the King's Road running from Wailevu to Soa, 4.III.1979.
50. Viti Levu, Namuaimanda, 5 km N of Nanukuloa, 100 m, 5.III.1979, disturbed forest.
51. Viti Levu, SE of Nanukuloa, between Narikoso and Naso Bay (a new road runs from Narikoso eastwards to the coast), 4 km E of Narikoso, 5.III.1979, disturbed rainforest with open canopy and gardens.
52. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, Southern Ridge Road, 800 m, 6.III.1979, primary montane rainforest.
53. Viti Levu, Nandrau Plateau, 5 km NW of Monasavu, 900 m, 7.III.1979, very wet moss forest.
54. Viti Levu, Nandrau Plateau, 5 km NW of Monasavu, 900 m, 7.III.1979, roadside with adjacent disturbed moss forest.
55. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, Forestry Resthouse, 800 m, 8.III.1979, montane rainforest, disturbed forest and Pinus plantations, at light.
56. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, trail to Nanggaranambululi, 2 km E of Nandarivatu, 1000-1100 m, 9.III.1979, montane rain forest partly disturbed, Pinus plantations and trail sides.
57. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, Forestry Resthouse, 800 m, 9.III.1979, montane rainforest, disturbed forest and Pinus plantations, at light.
58. Viti Levu, Tomanivi (Mt Victoria) at low altitude, 800 m (approach of Tomanivi from Navai), 10.III.1979, primary rainforest, disturbed rainforest and gardens.

59. Viti Levu, Nandarivatu, Forestry Resthouse, 800 m, 10.III.1979, montane rainforest, disturbed forest and Pinus plantations, at light.
60. Viti Levu, Nausori Highlands, 10 km E of Nausori, 400-600 m, 12.III.1979, rainforest, much disturbed in some places by logging.
61. Viti Levu, 15 km E of Lautoka, 13.III.1979, a valley with rainforest amidst extensive grassland and Pinus plantations; the rainforest covers about 1 km² and is isolated from other such patches by grassland and Pinus.
62. Viti Levu, Nausori Highlands, 15 km E of Nausori, 500 m, 14-15.III.1979, rainforest, much disturbed in some places by logging.
63. same as Station 62, but 16.III.1979.
64. South Viti Levu, 10-15 km N of Namboutini, about half-way along the road from the coast to Nambukelevu, 300 m, 20.III.1979, disturbed rainforest with mahogany plantations.
65. South Viti Levu, 3 km N of Votualailai along the road from the south-coast inland, 200 m, 20.III.1979, intermediate dry zone fringe forest.
66. South Viti Levu, half-way between Korolevu and Komave runs a new road inland to a saw mill, collections were made 5 km inland along the road, 300 m, 21.III,1979, rainforest, logged many years ago.
67. South Viti Levu, 10 km N of Ngaloa (Ngaloa is situated along the coast half-way between Namboutini and Navua) along the road to Waimbongi, 15 km NW of Navua, 200 m, 22.III.1979, heavily logged rainforest; also collected along the road in grass and lower vegetation.
68. South Viti Levu, 5 km N. of Navua along Wainikavika creek, 23.III.1979, wet pasture.
69. SE Viti Levu, 10 km W. of Naimasimasi, 20 km NNW of Nausori and SE of the Tailevu (Mahogany) Forest Plantation, 25.III.1979, primary lowland rainforest.
70. Ovalau, Lovoni, Central Ovalau, 28-29.III.1979, rainforest and adjacent gardens.
