SYNONYMICAL REMARK

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Diochares Eugenius m. Abh. Ber. Mus. Dresden, 1896/97, N°. 11, p. 5 = (*Monohammus rarus*) (Thoms.), Arch. ent. I., 1857, p. 445, t. 17, fig. 7.

Gemminger and Harold have overlooked that Thomson says:

»Cet insecte (*Monohammus rarus*) doit rentrer dans mon IX^e groupe..... auprès *polyspilus*, *fimbriatus* etc.»

Probably they follow Pascoe (Trans. Ent. Soc. London, 3rd ser. vol. III, p. 291) who transfers this species to *Dihammus*; but in my opinion it must be placed in the genus *Diochares*, the mesosternum being produced exactly as in *Diochares fimbriatus* Oliv.
