This conference volume contains a wide range of interesting papers on recent research in Rubiaceae and related families (Gentianaceae, Gentianales, Apocynaceae) including data on molecular research, morphology, and phylogenetics.

T. WHITTEN & J. WHITTEN (Volume eds.): **Plants.** Indonesian Heritage, Vol. 4. Editions Didier Millet, 1996. 144 pp., illus. ISBN 981-3018-32-1. Price unknown.

Indonesian Heritage is a 15-volume encyclopedia about Indonesia. Volume 4, 'Plants', discusses a bounty of topics arranged in sections on: Diversity of the Indonesian flora, Vegetation types and Biogeography, Plant-Animal interactions, People and Plants: Forest produce, People and Plants: Cultivation, and Conservation. A glossary, bibliography and index complete this beautifully executed volume.

Two parts of a presumably three-part Flora of the Desmids of Austria. With user-friendly identification tools, descriptions, and lots of illustrations. The bibliography is far from perfect. However, these volumes are recommended as a valuable publication.
