L. SCHULMAN, L. JUNIKKA, A. MNDOLWA & I. RAJAB: **Trees of Amani Nature Reserve NE Tanzania**. The Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism, Tanzania, 1998. 336 pp., illus. ISBN 9987-464-01-8. Price: c. GBP 25.00.

A handsome book on the tree species of a nature reserve in Tanzania. From the introduction and explanation onwards it is clear that the authors aim at a user group that includes non-systematists. A rather innovative and illustrative key for identification is used, also in several pages small tables discussing differences between similar looking species are given. Ample use has been made of 'forestry' characters like bark, exudate, etc. All species are illustrated, often including a picture of the slash of the bark.
