V. STATE OF PROGRESS IN MALAYSIAN PLANT TAXONOMY (cntd from pl. 160)

Ardisia. Dr W. H. Walker, National Herbarium, Smithsonian Institution, Washington, DC., has started a revision of Ardisia in Malaysia.

Casuarínaceae. Mr J. S. Johnson, Sydney Botanical Gardens, has agreed to revise Casuarinaceae for the Flora Malesiana.

Dioscoreaceae. Mr. I. H. Burkill finished the MS. of Dioscoreaceae for the Flora Malesiana.

Eucalyptus and Scleria. Mr S. J. Blake, Brisbane Herbarium, has agreed to revise Malaysian Eucalyptus and Scleria.

Ficus. Mr E. J. H. Corner, Cambridge, England, has started work on Malaysian Ficus.

Gentiana. Dr H. Smith, Uppsala, will revise the genus Gentiana.

Gnetaceae. Prof. Dr F. Markgraf, Munich, Germany, finished his MS. on the Gnetaceae for the Flora Malesiana.

Gramineae. Mr. C. A. Gardner, Government Botanist, Perth, West Australia announces the publication of vol. 1, part 3, of the Flora of Western Australia (Gramineae) in the latter half of 1950.

Loganiaceae. Dr C. A. Backer has consented to revise the family of Loganiaceae in Malaysia for the Flora.

Malvaceae. Mr J. van Borssum Waalkes, Bogor, started a revision of Malaysian Malvaceae.

Rubiaceae. Dr R. C. Bakhuizen van den Brink Jr. Leyden, has finished the revision of Javan Rubiaceae and is now working on some Rubiaceaus genera for the whole of the Malaysian area in preparation of the revision of Rubiaceae for the Flora Malesiana.

Schima. Prof. Dr S. Bloembergen has made a thorough study of the genus Schima (Theac.) mainly based on Malaysian materials.

Strophantus. Dr J. Monachino, New York, revises the genus Strophantus.
